Several local award-winning chefs will orchestrate a unique culinary experience to take place in the very same kitchen and dining room that serves individuals experiencing homelessness five days each week. This year's *Come to the Table* will be a celebration of our 15-year anniversary and those who make this work possible as we honor our past and plan for our future.

The doors to The Beacon opened on January 6, 2007, welcoming approximately 100 individuals experiencing homelessness with a homemade meal, hot shower, and opportunity to wash their clothes. Soon, more than 500 individuals were being served daily, amplifying Christ Church Cathedral's hundred-year tradition of meeting the needs of indigent Houstonians.

As we reflect on our beginnings, we are mindful that this effort took an enormous amount of planning and support by many individuals. In particular, those who organized committees to listen and learn about the needs of the homeless community, engineered operations within our facility and gave their time and treasure made the vision The Beacon a reality. These Faithful Founders remain loyal to our mission to this day and have inspired so many others to join them.

In its 15-year history, The Beacon has evolved, honing its services, and creating efficiencies with separate non-profits merging into one. Our role within the community-wide homeless response system remains vital and our reputation as a dependable resource for individuals in need is paramount.
